Octagonal, striped, damascus barrels, numbered 1 & 2 respectively and marked on the top: Striped by Le Page; breechblock inlaid with gold; breech tails inlaid with gold. Flat bodied locks, line engraved and signed Fni. By Lepage. Percussion action. Trigger tails with stetchers. Jaspersed finger rests on the bridges, ending in bouquets.

Steel case-hardened counterplates with engraved spider web wings. Jaspersed and engraved olive caps. Barrel mounts carved with shells on the
