This would have been imported into France during the late nineteenth century when the fashion for things Japanese was at it height.

The art form known as shibayama is named after the Shibayama area of present-day Chiba prefecture. The shibayama technique was created by Onoki Senzo, an Edo haberdasher who lived during the An'ei era (1772-1781). His style of ivory inlaying became so popular that he named works done with the inlay technique after his hometown of Shibayama and later also adopted this name as his surname.
