This weight is monogrammed on the back MV it dates from 1924 He must not have been happy the merchant who was checked in 1937 (nice mark) 1939 and six others . . control punches which testify to the great use of the object. It presents, on both sides many traces of its life..... 13cm in diameter, 1.5 cm high and one cm thick.
