The painting depicts a marine scene on a stormy night: Noël beautifully expresses the dramatic atmosphere of the storm with the detailed rendering of the sea waves, the sailboats and boats struggling forward and the realistic rendering of the sky given by the modular bluish-gray tones.

Alexandre Jean Noël was a highly appreciated artist for his numerous gouaches and watercolors of seascapes and landscapes. Aged only sixteen,
