Black pencil and chalk 133x103cm with frame 100x72cm drawing only Heavy and quality frame, contact us for delivery. Rik Slabbinck is a Belgian artist born in Bruges in 1914 and died in 1991. He was a painter, draftsman and graphic designer. Studied at the Academy of Bruges (1933-1935) and at Sint-Lucas in Ghent. Worked for a year and a half under C. Permeke. Initially worked in the dark atmosphere of Permeke, but from around 1950, his palette gradually lightened. Landscapes, still lifes, nudes, portraits. Away from expressionism. He was influenced by fauvism. Loved the hard colours and beautiful contrasting surfaces. Worked with the palette
