Rare and unusual gilded wooden reliquary, with a relic of St. Ambrose. Later crucified in black ink (Latin cross on a mountain with three peaks?) Very small chippings Italy, 18th century In prayer, next to the people He distributed all his goods to the poor and devoted himself to the study of the Sacred Texts and the Fathers of the Church: "When I read the Scriptures," he said, "God walks with me in Paradise." He learned to preach and his oratory fascinated the young Augustine of Hippo, marking his conversion. Ambrose's life became increasingly frugal and austere, spent entirely in study, prayer, assiduous listening and closeness to the poor and the people of God.
