arranged in curls. All wings spread, the right arm
stretched in the air and forward (2 fingers
restored and two others missing; see photos), the
left arm holding/wearing a laurel crown, symbol
of victory. She is dressed in a light dress, with
drapery rendered in a classical manner, leaning,
the right foot on a half-sphere emanating from
stylized waves. Multiple restorations (fingers of
the right hand, shoulders, wings). Classical
allegory typical of its period. Good general
