Description

This stunning French torchère, dating from the late 19th century, is an elegant and richly ornamented piece crafted in hand-carved wood, with a partially gilded and polychrome finish. Standing on an elaborately decorated tripod base, it features beautifully sculpted scrolls, volutes, and acanthus leaves, characteristic of the Baroque and Rococo revival styles popular during this period.

The torchère's tall, slender column is divided into multiple sections, each adorned with intricate carvings and decorative motifs, lending it a sense of movement and refinement. The top platform, with its carved and gilded border, was likely designed to hold a large candle, making this piece a pricket candlestick, originally used for
