Some tools are marked "FVANS" or "IVANS" or "S. MAW & SON LONDON". United Kingdom. Second half of the 19th century. Fairly good condition, case with cracks and some missing parts, missing key, interior lining exposed with traces of oxidation of the instruments, some instruments with oxidation.
