Artist Biography Miguel Ángel Echaury (b. 1927) is a Spanish painter known for his realistic and moody representations of landscapes and still lifes. His training under the Navarrese painter Javier Ciga shaped his disciplined approach to composition and his restrained, earthy color palette. Echaury's work often exhibits a strong sense of solitude and contemplation, achieved through his use of shadow and high contrast. Having spent several years in Latin America, particularly in Uruguay and Argentina, his exposure to different landscapes influenced his visual language. His work is included in significant collections, including the Museo Nacional de Artes Visuales in Montevideo, Uruguay, and the Miguel Echaury Foundation in Pamplona, Spain.
