Description

Sandstone sculpture representing the head of Christ, dating from the Romanesque period (10th - 12th century). The Romanesque period is marked by a strong religious fervor and the development of sacred art, notably through sculpture intended for churches and monasteries. This sculpted head, probably from a larger ensemble, bears witness to this artistic and spiritual context. The work rests on a wooden base, highlighting its ancient character and its remarkable presence. An authentic piece full of history, ideal for lovers of medieval art.
