Description

Pair of vases in fine Limoges porcelain, made between the end of the 19th and the beginning of the 20th century. The floral decoration, composed of chrysanthemums in pink, purple and gold hues, is displayed on an ivory background, bringing finesse and balance to the whole. The vases adopt a slender shape with a slightly narrowed neck, characteristic of the style of this period. Golden threads highlight the contours and structure the composition. Limoges porcelain, recognized for its quality and refinement, is distinguished here by its careful and precise work. These vases illustrate the know-how of the Limoges manufacturers and fit equally well into a collection as into a classic and elegant decoration.
