French school of the 18th century portrait to be of Louise Bénédicte de Bourbon, known as "Mademoiselle d'Enghien", princess of France.Oil on canvas 90 x 71 cm.Louis XIV period frame gilded with gold leaf 113 x 92 cm.Anne Louise Bénédicte de Bourbon Mademoiselle d'henghien (8 November 1676 - 23 January 1753) was the daughter of Henri Jules de Bourbon, Prince of Condé, and Anne Henriette of Bavaria.As a member of the reigning House of Bourbon, she was a princess of the blood.Forced to marry the Duke of Maine, legitimized son of Louis XIV and Madame de Montespan, she delighted in politics and the arts, and held a popular salon at the Hôtel du Maine as well as at the Château de Sceaux.
