Clock, skeleton of the Directoire period in gilded bronze. The dial is signed by Armingaud in Paris who was active, rue Meslay boulevard de la porte Saint-Martin in Paris from 1806-1813. the base, in the shape of a shuttle in Vénés marble in red and green color chart rests on 4 feet in gilded bronze. Sun pendulum. This clock is made for bedrooms, since it does not have a chime. In good working order. It is decorated with a gardening trophy, ribbon and oak leaves as well as laurel branches. Literature dictionary of documentation, French complicated clockmaking by Tardy.
