Jaroslav Spillar, known as Trávníček, (October 11, 1869, Plzen[1] - November 30, 1917, Dobrany near Plzen), was a Czech painter who worked mainly in the Chodsko region.

Jaroslav Spillar was born into the family of a financial official, Antonín Spillar, and his wife, Frantiska. His younger brothers Karel Spillar and Rudolf Vojtech Spillar were also visual artists. Jaroslav Spillar was one of the first students of the newly established School of Applied Arts in
