Dvorák transformed his academic training into works in the neo-romantic and symbolist style. His works from his stay in Paris, as well as those of Mucha, Masek and Marold, contributed to the formation of the style of the period. A typical work, demonstrating Dvorák's contribution to turn-of-the-century art, is considered to be his The Reader, which was exhibited at the Paris Salon in 1896. It was influenced by the colours and style of the Pre-Raphaelites.[16] His interest

in the Orient and esotericism led him, after his return from the United States, to try to capture the magical expression of reality (for example, the painting *The Sound Cosmos* of 1910-1914).

Modernist criticism of the first half of the 20th century classified Frantisek Dvorák among the academic, technically refined authors, in keeping with the decadent bourgeois taste.
