Signed by Émile Picault (1833-1915), this work reflects the 19th century's fascination with mythology and antiquity. Picault, renowned for his allegorical sculptures, captures a sense of movement and strength, paying tribute to the power of the horse and the authority of the god. With its meticulous craftsmanship and precise details, this piece showcases the artistic skill of its time.
