On a drawing by Christiane Vauzelles in 1967, this beautiful pleated square is called "Selles à Housse", and represents capital letters "H" intertwined with stirrups and saddles on a background of fleurs-de-lys. Bears its title, its copyright and the acronym of the house of Hermès. In silk twill with well-puffed hand-rolled edges, it comes in shades of blue, red, white, gold... The silk is still very beautiful, the colors well saturated. Dimensions: 127 cm from one point to the other at the longest of the pleat and 44 cm at the shortest of the pleat. In very good original condition, of use and conservation, no stain, no hole or pulled thread, see the details on the photos.
