Do not hesitate to ask us for more information on this talented ceramicist. "High trapezoid stele. OLD SUMERIAN period (2750-2350 BC) Cylinder seal impression in black hematite. (H 52 mm x diam 16 mm) A line at the top and bottom of the cylinder defines the register. Three characters, side by side with triangular heads and the ends of the hands and feet represented by three fingers (like birds). The one on the right stretches out his two arms. Above a bird, at his feet a small animal. Central character has his arms along his body. Below his right hand three horizontal lines and a geometric symbol. Last character stretches out his arms above an animal raised towards him.
