18K gold and silver necklace, set with rose-cut diamonds, Napoleon III period Superb 18K gold and silver necklace, dating from the Napoleon III period (circa 1860-1880), illustrating the refinement and elegance of Second Empire jewelry. This jewel is adorned with rose-cut diamonds, mounted on silver around the settings, a technique typical of this period aimed at enhancing the brilliance of the stones.

Exceptional goldsmith work The pendant has a superb openwork and chiseled decoration, in a naturalist and romantic style. It is embellished with two small finely decorated balls, suspended on each side, as well as a central gold tassel, animating the jewel with a graceful movement. The main motif is enhanced by three natural pearls located on the necklace attachment, adding

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a touch of softness and contrast to the sparkling diamonds. Please note that on the central tassel, the hanging diamond is an old cut, different from the other stones which are rose cut.
