Although Joseph was the oldest of the suitors, presented to Maris, his reed branch turned green as a divine sign of God's choice, the doves appearing above their heads, a sign of the Happiness of the moment. The Father and Mother of Jesus will therefore have a child carried on earth "Jesus", for all Christian humanity by becoming a symbol of their piety This beautiful large quality canvas has always been maintained and restored with a doubling of the
