Description

This glass paste vase by Daum Nancy depicts a lakeside landscape in warm shades of orange and brown. The multi-layer glass technique used here allows for a play of depth and light that brings the trees and reflections on the water to life. The decoration, obtained by acid etching, brings a finesse and subtle relief to the whole. Daum Nancy is a glass house that established itself at the end of the 19th century as a major player in the Art Nouveau movement. Inspired by nature and landscapes, its artisans developed innovative methods to create pieces with a timeless aesthetic. This vase perfectly illustrates this spirit, with a scene that evokes the calm of a lakeside at dusk. Its slightly curved black foot gives it elegant stability, while the slender silhouette highlights the details of the decoration. This type of vase
