Solid silver planter, "Jonc" model by Wolfers, Brussels, late 19th century Magnificent planter in 800 thousandths solid silver, made by the goldsmith Wolfers, one of the greatest names in Brussels goldsmithing. This is the emblematic "Jonc" model, inspired by the aquatic plant of the same name and characteristic of the Louis XV style revisited at the end of the 19th century. This quadriporal model features a sumptuous Rocaille decoration, adorned with volutes, foliage, floral motifs and stylized waves, giving the piece a baroque elegance. The interior is lined with a gilded brass lining, in perfect condition. Resting on four richly decorated feet, this planter combines balance and refinement. Its quality of execution, its finely chiseled details and its assertive style bear witness to the exceptional
