On one side, a smooth, intact natural agate, historically used for engraving wax seals, coats of arms or initials. Here, the stone is blank, offering the possibility of personalization according to the wishes of its future owner. On the other side, an opening photo holder compartment, designed to store a precious image or souvenir. This type of jewelry, both sentimental and practical, was prized at the time for keeping intimate memories close to oneself. The setting is finely crafted with an articulated structure and delicate decoration, typical of
