Presence of the Minerva's head hallmark 950 thousandth and master goldsmith's hallmark CT with a cruet for Charles Eugène Trioullier (1844 - 1863) Object of very good quality in very good condition with slight wear of the gilding on the shaft but less marked on the ciborium than in the photos.
