Our painting represents a chiaroscuro in the manner of Caravaggio who sublimated this art. Margherita Caffi borrowed this style in which she excels, in fact the light emerges from the darkness and floods the bouquet, the flowers as in a trompe l'oeil come out of the painting and give the impression of being able to be taken. Strange technique and surprising experience, on this painting, the panel was gilded with gold leaf before being painted. The only explanation to my taste would be that the gold would give
