Elegant and harmonious fruit cup in the center of the table. In solid silver, its lively contours are richly decorated with foliage. The rim forms a large and important frieze of panels of leafy and flowering rose branches between pendants and crosspieces, The bowl rests on a discreet circular pedestal, finely chiseled with a braid of small cherry leaves and fruits, the plain throat. Normal micro-scratches from use, no shock or any deformation. Excellent conditions for this spring fruit serving bowl. Master goldsmith: Amédée Gravoin received in 1902 in Paris (A. G, a clover) 520 gr, diameter: 26.5 cm, / 10.43 in. Height - height: 6 cm. / 2.26 in. The cup is engraved on the pedestal and on the outline with the hallmark of master goldsmith Amédée Gravoin (2) as well as that of the French guarantee Minerva's head
