Early Rattanakosin period (1782 - 1932), although earlier influences of the Ayutthaya style are perceptible in the treatment of faces and ornaments. These statues are often placed at the entrance to temples or on family altars in Thailand. They symbolize spiritual protection and perpetual offering to Buddha.
