Description

Silver plated meat and game dish cover, Old Sheffield, late 19th century. Superb silver plated meat and game dish cover, made by Old Sheffield in England, dating from the late 19th century. Intended for serving meat, game and poultry, this set is distinguished by its inclined system allowing cooking juices to be collected in a hollowed-out area of the dish, thus offering a practical and elegant solution for preserving natural sauces. The set has a gadrooned finish, characteristic of the English style of the period, bringing a refined touch to its contours. This detail is found both on the edge of the dish and on the cover, accentuating its elegance and authenticity. The imposing handle of the cover is richly decorated with bunches of grapes and vine leaves, a delicate decoration that evokes the art of

the British table. A rare detail: this piece is free of any engraving or coat of arms, which is unusual for an English silver plated dish, these pieces being often personalized with monograms or family coats of arms.
