Solid silver biscuit box, Dutch work from the early 20th century. Elegant 833 thousandths solid silver biscuit box, of Dutch origin, dating from the early 20th century. This superb object is decorated with a richly chased decoration, typical of Dutch goldsmithing of the period. The lid is entirely embossed and finely engraved with a lively scene representing a group of 17th century gentlemen seated at a table in an inn. The atmosphere is lively: some are chatting animatedly, while others are smoking pipes or handling various objects. The background is richly detailed, with a monumental fireplace, hangings and various pieces of furniture evoking a warm atmosphere typical of Dutch taverns of the Golden Age. The walls of the box are decorated with relief work representing village

scenes, surrounded by an interweaving of floral motifs and finely chased foliage.
