Late 19th or early 20th century, gilded bronze mount, pearled at the neck, decorated with garlands with a flower basket and the other with musical instruments. The 2 vases signed with an Axe for the ASCH Manufacture founded by Frédéric Gustave ASH (1856-1911) which lasted until the year 1980. Very good condition (a few scratches on the garlands, the garlands are removable for easier maintenance.
