He is a friend of the artists Fernand Léger, Joan Miró, Piet Mondrian. Alexander Calder Hand-knotted in Merino wool. Very good quality wool. Size : 250x200 cm Condition : Good condition, slight variation in the weave: the beige wool turns gray (this effect is due to the color of the beige and gray wool threads used), which can make it look
