BackgroundThe Chelsea porcelain factory was one of the most important English porcelain manufacturers of the 18th century, renowned for its high-quality soft-paste porcelain and exquisite Rococo decorations. Chelsea figurines from this period were highly prized among the English aristocracy, often used as table decorations or cabinet pieces. The Gold Anchor period (c. 1756-1769) represents one of the factory's final phases before its merger with Derby, making pieces from this time especially sought after by collectors due to their refinement and detailed execution. Chelsea's influence on English porcelain was profound, setting a standard for artistry that inspired later manufacturers. Today, Chelsea porcelain remains a symbol of 18th-century elegance, with pieces treasured in museums and private collections worldwide.
