Description

The "Caribù" floor lamp, designed in 1972 by Lella Montecroci and Marco de Carli for Arrelam, is an iconic piece of Italian design from the 1970s.

Its ingenious system allows for height adjustment as well as rotation of the lampshade, offering great flexibility of use.
