



# "dolphin" Chandelier Attr. To Maison Baguès, France, Circa 1900

### Description

Rare Louis XVI-inspired chandelier in crystal and chiseled and gilded bronze with six lights. It is composed of a lit covered basin in gadrooned cut crystal, covered on its base with large leaves ending in a seed. It is surrounded by a frieze of pearls on which rest six dolphins spitting water serving as supports for the light-arms. Six beaded chains adorned with crystals connect the light-arms to the wrapped torus crowning the upper thread.

### Biography :

Art light creator, Baguès was founded around 1840 in Auvergne. Specialized in liturgical bronzes, the company grew at the end of the 19th century and started to make lighting bronzes,
