"THE WEEPING WILLOW" Seditious engraving from the 18th century representing an allegory of French Royalty weeping, at the foot of a funeral urn, the memory of King Louis XVI, Marie-Antoinette, the Dauphin, Madame Royale and Madame Elisabeth, whose profiles appear on either side of the urn and in the branches of the willow. Good general state of conservation with the presence of dampness, in particular halos on the lower, right part.
