Description

Nymph of Diana by Mrs. Signoret-Ledieu"
Known under the title "Nymph of Diana", this statue represents Diana the Huntress leaning over a dolphin emerging from the waves. Important bronze group with original medal patina, placed on a rotating base (width 31 cm), H86 cm old cast from the late 19th century, numbered and benefiting from remarkable quality work. The base is included in the height indicated. On the base appears the name of the author Mrs. Signoret Ledieu A Basset publisher and foundry stamp Paris AB and numbered 10436 who had presented a copy of this sculpture at the 1891 Salon. Work of very beautiful appearance according to its age, slight alteration of use of the patina. Lucie Signoret-Ledieu was born in 1858 in Nevers, she was trained in her art with the sculptor Jean
