soft, radiant tones, forming a rhythmic frame around the central field evoking a sense of balance and elegance.

Silow's use of colour is both restrained and effective, giving the work a soft radiance and a touch of warmth that invites the viewer to appreciate its subtle intricacies.

The design features a series of interlocking shapes, creating a dynamic visual play that captures the essence of traditional Swedish weaving techniques. Silow's mastery of form and symmetry is evident in the careful arrangement and repetition of the motifs, each contributing to the overall sense of harmony and continuity that defines the work.
