Jean Garnier (1853-1930), sculptor, enameler and chaser from Mouzeuil-Saint-Martin, in Vendée. Self-taught, he mastered various materials such as marble, terracotta, bronze and pewter. He also created enamel jewelry. He had a notable career in Paris, regularly participating in the Salon from 1883 to 1905, before returning to his native region in 1910. His works include Art Nouveau
