He trained at the Middelburg drawing school, then became a student of JH Koekkoek and Pieter van Hanselaere (portrait and landscape painter in Ghent). His paintings are very finely done and bathed in a beautiful light, our painting is an example of this. He is of course inspired by the old Dutch masters who excelled in this genre (as shown in "Figures on the Ice, a Koek en Zopie in the Background" (1856), sold for EUR16,000 by
