Koto tanto Epoque MOMOYAMA (1573 - 1603)A complete Tanto...With his little Kozuka knife...In perfect condition...And complete with origin...JAPANESE origin...From the middle of the 16th century...With the blade in forged steel...Brass ring...The handle is made of wood covered in shagreen...Gold-gilded bronze badges...It's the golden copper menuki featuring paulownia and dragon...Under the weapons of the Toyotomi family...Which are themselves held by a cotton braid...Its tip is made of lacquered brass and the over-decorations are made of gold-gilded brass...The scabbard (saya) is made of wood, with lacquered leather work in several shades...The attachment to hang on the belt is made of lacquered wood and the tips are made of gold-gilded brass...It is the kozuja in shibuichi
