Her throat is largely bare, the woman is not wearing jewelry. The work is placed on a worked gray background, we can guess a sketch of a landscape in the background.

The woman has a pink complexion; she seems lost in her thoughts and smiles slightly.

This is a delicate, peaceful, very decorative portrait.

The work is in very good condition. On the back, we note two minor restorations. The work is offered in a gilded and stuccoed wooden frame,
