Description of the work

This magnificent gouache by Caroline Berthod, a 19th century artist, represents an animated Italian landscape, featuring the famous Tivoli waterfalls. The work, signed lower right, is a precious artistic testimony to the romantic fascination with the picturesque landscapes of Italy.

The artist plays with an immersive perspective: In the foreground, a pastoral scene with characters in traditional clothing, energizing the composition.

In the center, a basin reflects the colors of the sky, offering a beautiful light effect.

In the background, an impressive cascading stream, dominated by ancient buildings and classical remains, recalling the historical importance of Tivoli, the birthplace of the Villa d'Este and Villa Adriana.

Palette and technique

The work is distinguished by a delicate palette, typical of the gouaches of this period:

Ochre and brown tones for the rocks and ancient buildings, evoking the warmth of the Italian landscape.

Deep greens and nuanced blues for the lush vegetation, bringing freshness to the scene.

Gradients of blue and orange in the sky, creating a soft and romantic atmosphere.

The meticulous work of shadows and light brings a subtle realism, while the architectural details and the draperies of the characters reveal the artist's technical mastery.

Historical and artistic context

Caroline Berthod is part of the tradition of 19th century romantic landscape painters, influenced by travels in Italy and the discovery of ancient sites. The Tivoli waterfalls, made famous by many artists and writers, inspired painters such as Hubert Robert, Corot and Turner. This work therefore perfectly illustrates this artistic heritage where nature and history intertwine.
