Bow-Wood" armchair, created in the 1950s and produced by the renowned French manufacturer Steiner (label present). Curved light wood structure, a technique emblematic of post-war modernist furniture, reflecting the democratization of design during this period. Seat and backrest in skai (faux leather). The seat requires restoration, but the structure and backrest remain in very good original condition. This model exemplifies the aesthetic and functional innovations pursued by Steiner during the "Trente Glorieuses" era.
