The top drawer, discreetly integrated into the belt of the piece, combines aesthetics with practicality, while a hidden drawer in the plinth adds an element of mystery and security. The later brass keyhole escutcheons, seamlessly integrated, along with the original key, attest to the meticulous attention to detail in the finishes. The Sainte-Anne marble top, adorned with a refined molding known as "paire de fesses," softens the lines and brings a sense of visual harmony. This finishing touch, requiring meticulous polishing, showcases the 19th-century cabinetmakers' dedication to excellence and precision. Timelessly elegant, this chest of drawers seamlessly fits into a classic, romantic, or contemporary interior seeking authenticity. Its excellent original condition, with no restorations, makes it a rare piece that has preserved all its soul and period charm. Originating from a distinguished family in the Loire Valley, this chest of drawers stands as a testament to a rich historical heritage.
