Device intended to hold wood chips or candles of different diameters.

Tripod foot with folded bases.

Rare candle holder with a cross decoration and three sockets.

This model may date from the 17th or 18th century.

Good condition, beautiful patina protected by a thin layer of burnt colorless wax.
