The café was frequented by all levels of society, we even see a prelate there. It is even said in chronicles of the time that it was a shady place.... The coffee was distributed by a man who carried a fountain on his back. The sign is engraved upside down because these engravings were intended to be seen in a lighting and reflecting device, the
