Charming pair of oil on copper, with the vivid polychromy of a 17th century Flemish school in a gilded wooden frame. Joseph and Mary present the Child at the temple, they are received by Simeon, an old man.

They also present a pair of doves as a sacrifice. This is the first representation proposed. The second iconography is the continuation of the presentation at the temple with the episode of circumcision. The Gospel according to Luke evokes it "And when the eight days for his circumcision were completed, he was called by the name of Jesus, the name given by the angel before his conception"
