Description

The pitchers are initially turned, then various decorative elements, branches, leaves, grapes, a character on a barrel or at a table are stamped and glued on or modeled separately and added to the pot. Then the stoneware, after drying, is fired at a high temperature, over 1100°. This vitrifies the stoneware. The firing was formerly done with wood, which gives a brown and glossy tint to the pitchers. Even if they were produced in several copies, they are all different in the turning, the decoration and the firing, often with wood or gas. (1) Man on a barrel with vine decoration in applique and in relief. HT 22.5 cm diameter 12 cm, small chip (2) Fisherman .HT 22.5 cm diameter 13 cm, good condition (3) Bouquet of flowers Ht 24.5 cm diameter 12.5 cm, good condition (4) Vine decoration, missing branch
