A rare and highly collectible Royal Dux figure, this model is considered one of the factory's finest designs. In the 20th century, large-scale Art Nouveau figurines like this were no longer produced, making this an especially desirable piece. By the late 19th and early 20th centuries, Royal Dux was internationally acclaimed for its innovative designs and superior craftsmanship. The company received prestigious awards, including: Grand Prix at the 1900 Paris Exhibition Gold Medal at the 1905 Liège Exhibition Further accolades at exhibitions in Brussels and Turin Today, Royal Dux porcelain remains highly sought after by collectors and enthusiasts worldwide.
